

Dear Fellow WPC Congregants,

Many people the world over with few, if any, resources are struggling mightily to provide their families with water, food, clothing, shelter, medical care, education, etc. Unemployment and severe weather in many parts of the world are having catastrophic effects on millions of people. And continued unrest in many places continue to displace or harm untold numbers of others.

As Christians, we have been called to help our neighbors near and far, to care for them as though they are part of our family. This call to serve is especially critical now that so many U.S. funds that were used to alleviate suffering have been cut off. We can't address all of the world's needs, but through Dedicated Mission Giving we can support charities who desperately need funding so that they might continue to minister to those in the greatest need of light and hope.

We cannot help but be reminded daily that there are many in need not only in our local community but the world over, men, women, and children who have dreams they cannot attain without a helping hand. To this end, I invite you to pray about how you might help them address critical needs so that faith and hope might be restored thereby allowing them become all they were created to be.

One of the easiest ways you might consider doing this is through Westminster Presbyterian Women (WPW) Dedicated Giving. In 2025, WPW donated \$5,125 to local charitable organizations and \$9,446 to global missions, i.e., PDA/kids kits/PW offerings/global charities (2,446) and the PCUSA World Mission Fund (\$7,000). This was made possible because of monies received through Dedicated and Circle giving, pecan sales and investment dividends. WPW also physically supported Westminster Presbyterian Church (13 memorial receptions) as well as those in need beyond its walls, i.e., 150 school kits built/delivered to Church World Service and through our Period Justice Project (period supplies provided to those in need within our community).
